- 11 Section 10. Limitation of tuition increase.
- 12 Notwithstanding any other law of this State, beginning with
- 13 the 2003-2004 academic year and in each academic year
- 14 thereafter the governing board of a public institution of
- 15 higher education shall not increase or authorize an increase
- in the rate of undergraduate tuition charged at any campus of
- 17 a university under its jurisdiction by an amount that is
- 18 greater than the lesser of the following: (i) 5% of the

applicable rate of tuition that was charged

- 20 immediately preceding academic year; or (ii) the result

obtained when the applicable rate of tuition that was charged

- in the immediately preceding academic year is multiplied by

- 25 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
