- 9 (a) Every application for any permit or license
- 10 authorized to be issued under this Act shall be made upon a
- 11 form furnished by the Secretary of State. Every application
- 12 shall be accompanied by the proper fee and payment of such
- 13 fee shall entitle the applicant to not more than 3 attempts
- 14 to pass the examination within a period of 1 year after the

The 12 Secretary of State may utilize a photograph process or system most suitable to deter alteration or improper reproduction of 13 a drivers license and to prevent substitution of another 14 15 photo thereon.

(c) The application form shall include a notice to the applicant of the registration obligations of sex offenders under the Sex Offender Registration Act. The notice shall be provided in a form and manner prescribed by the Secretary of State. For purposes of this subsection (c), "sex offender" has the meaning ascribed to it in Section 2 of the Sex Offender Registration Act.

23 Any male United States citizen or immigrant applies for any permit or license authorized to be issued 24 25 under this Act or for a renewal of any permit or license, and who is at least 18 years of age but less than 26 years of 26 age, must be registered in compliance with the requirements 27 of the federal Military Selective Service Act. The Secretary 28 State must forward in an electronic format the necessary 29 30 personal information regarding the applicants identified in this subsection (d) to the Selective Service System. The 31 applicant's signature on the application serves as 32 an indication that the applicant either has already registered 33 34 with the Selective Service System or that he is authorizing

- 1 the Secretary to forward to the Selective Service System the
- 2 necessary information for registration. The Secretary must
- 3 notify the applicant at the time of application that his
- 4 signature constitutes consent to registration with the
- 5 Selective Service System, if he is not already registered.
