The Secretary of State 17 shall, however, determine which religious orders or sects 18 have such bona fide religious convictions. The Secretary of 19 20 State shall issue a drivers license to an applicant who is an 21 immigrant and ineligible for a social security number if the 22 applicant has (i) provided the Secretary with an individual 23 tax identification number; (ii) filed with the Secretary, at 24 the time of application, an affidavit stating that the 25 applicant is an immigrant and not eligible for a social security number and that the applicant will file an 26 27 application to become a permanent resident of the United States at the earliest opportunity the applicant is eligible 28 to do so; (iii) provided a current foreign passport and a 29 foreign birth certificate; and (iv) surrendered all illegally 30 31 obtained forms of drivers licenses or State identification cards issued to the applicant by the Secretary. 32 Relinquishment of State issued identification shall be 33 handled by the Secretary at his or her discretion. The 34

Secretary may also require any combination of additional documents, as set forth by administrative rule, as sufficient proof of residency or identification. The foreign passport and foreign birth certificate and any additional documents required may be accepted only if: (i) the passport and birth certificate and any additional documents are difficult to duplicate and (ii) the passport and birth certificate and any additional documents are verifiable with the issuing agency. This amendatory Act of the 93rd General Assembly does not affect the issuance of any commercial driver's license or

school bus driver's permit under the Illinois Vehicle Code or any State identification card under the Illinois

Identification Card Act.

The Secretary of State may, in his discretion, by rule or regulation, provide that an application for a drivers license or permit may include a suitable photograph of the applicant in the form prescribed by the Secretary, and he may further provide that each drivers license shall include a photograph of the driver. The Secretary of State may utilize a photograph process or system most suitable to deter alteration or improper reproduction of a drivers license and

(c) The application form shall include a notice to the applicant of the registration obligations of sex offenders under the Sex Offender Registration Act. The notice shall be provided in a form and manner prescribed by the Secretary of State. For purposes of this subsection (c), "sex offender" has the meaning ascribed to it in Section 2 of the Sex Offender Registration Act.
