- 4 Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
- 5 Practices Act is amended by adding Section 2MM as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2MM new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 2MM. Mail; disclosure. It is an unlawful practice</u>
- 8 <u>under this Act to knowingly mail or send or cause to be</u>
- 9 <u>mailed or sent a postcard or letter to a recipient in this</u>
- 10 State if:
- 11 (1) the postcard or letter contains a request that
- 12 <u>the recipient call a telephone number;</u>
- 13 (2) the postcard or letter is mailed or sent to
- induce the recipient to call the telephone number so that
- 15 goods, services, or other merchandise, as defined in
- Section 1, may be offered for sale to the recipient; and
- 17 (3) the postcard or letter does not disclose that
- 18 goods, services, or other merchandise, as defined in
