AN ACT concerning taxes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
Manufactured Home Installation Act.

6 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act:

"Manufactured home" is synonymous with "mobile home" and 7 8 means a structure that is a factory-assembled, completely integrated structure designed for permanent habitation, with 9 a permanent chassis and so constructed as to permit its 10 transport, on wheels temporarily or permanently attached to 11 its frame, from the place of its construction to the 12 13 location, or subsequent locations, at which it is placed on a support system for use as a permanent habitation, and 14 15 designed and situated so as to permit its occupancy as a 16 dwelling place for one or more persons. The term "manufactured home" includes manufactured homes constructed 17 18 after June 30, 1976 in accordance with the federal National Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety Standards Act of 19 20 1974 and does not include an immobilized mobile home as defined in Section 2.10 of the Mobile Home Park Act. 21

22 "Mobile home park" means a tract of land or 2 or more 23 contiguous tracts of land that contain sites with the 24 necessary utilities for 5 or more manufactured homes either 25 free of charge or for revenue purposes.

Permanent foundation", for a manufactured home, means a continuous perimeter foundation of material such as mortared concrete block, mortared brick, or concrete that extends into the ground below the established frost depth and to which the home is secured with foundation bolts at least one-half inch in diameter, spaced at intervals of no more than 6 feet and

within one foot of the corners, and embedded at least 7
 inches into concrete foundations or 15 inches into block
 foundations.

4 Section 10. Installation requirements. A manufactured 5 home installed on private property that is not in a mobile 6 home park on or after the effective date of this Act must be 7 installed so that it rests wholly on a permanent foundation. 8 The permanent foundation must meet or exceed the requirements 9 for a permanent foundation as defined in this Act.

Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
