- 4 Section 5. The Department of Human Services Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 10-26 as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 10-26. Child care provider training.</u>
- 8 (a) The Department of Human Services, through the Child
- 9 <u>Care Resource and Referral Program, must expand current</u>
- 10 <u>education</u> and training for child care providers to include a
- 11 program that will educate child care providers concerning:
- 12 (1) the importance of healthy brain development in
- the first 3 years of a child's life;
- 14 (2) the identification of risk factors and
- 15 <u>behaviors that indicate that a child needs special</u>
- 16 <u>education or mental health services; and</u>
- 17 (3) how to provide parents with appropriate
- 18 <u>information regarding support or intervention services</u>
- 19 <u>available for suspected special needs or for the</u>
- behaviors identified in subsection (2).
- 21 (b) Training available from the Child Care Resource and
