- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Domesticated Wild Animals Act is amended
- 5 by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (510 ILCS 60/1) (from Ch. 8, par. 24)
- Sec. 1. Ownership when raised, domesticated, or enclosed.
- 8 All birds and animals ferae naturae or naturally wild,
- 9 including fur bearing animals not native to this State, when
- 10 raised or in domestication, or kept in enclosures and reduced
- 11 to possession, are hereby declared to be objects of ownership
- 12 and absolute title, the same as cattle and other property,
- and shall receive the same protection of law, and in the same
- 14 way and to the same extent shall be the subject of trespass
- or theft, as other personal property.
