2 AMENDMENT NO. ____. Amend Senate Bill 629 as follows:

3 on page 2, by replacing lines 8 through 21 with the 4 following:

"(c) Profits on sales from commissary stores shall 5 be б expended by the Department for the special benefit of committed persons which shall include but not limited to the 7 8 advancement of inmate payrolls, for the special benefit of 9 employees, and for the advancement or reimbursement of employee travel,-provided-that-amounts-expended-for-employees 10 shall--not--exceed--the--amount-of-profits-derived-from-sales 11 made-to-employees-by-such-commissaries, as determined by the 12 13 Department.

Any funds expended pursuant to this Section for the benefit of employees shall be allocated based on the recommendations of an Employee Benefit Committee to be comprised of equal numbers of representatives from management and the employees' collective bargaining representative at each facility."; and

20 by replacing line 33 on page 2 and lines 1 through 7 on page 21 3 with the following:

22 "<u>non-tobacco products</u> from-3%-through-10%. A compliance audit 23 of all"; and on page 3, line 21, by inserting after the period the following: "Nothing in this Section precludes the Department from continuing to contract with a private vendor at a facility at which commissary services have been operated by a private vendor prior to April 1, 2003.".
