- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Court Reporters Act is amended by adding
- 5 Sections 8.2 and 8.5 as follows:
- 6 (705 ILCS 70/8.2 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 8.2. Supreme Court; collective bargaining. The</u>
- 8 Supreme Court shall collectively bargain over wages, hours,
- 9 and terms and conditions of employment of all persons
- 10 <u>employed as court reporters in this State. The Supreme Court</u>
- 11 <u>shall recognize an exclusive bargaining representative of</u>
- 12 persons employed as court reporters in this State, if that
- 13 representative makes a showing, through an election or
- 14 <u>otherwise</u>, that it represents a majority of the court
- 15 reporters, in accordance with procedures for verifying
- 16 <u>majority status established by the Court.</u>

- 18 <u>Sec. 8.5. Advisory arbitration.</u>
- 19 (a) All matters concerning wages, hours, and terms and
- 20 <u>conditions of employment of court reporters are subject to</u>
- 21 <u>advisory</u>, <u>non-binding arbitration</u>.
- 22 (b) Any party to a collective bargaining agreement with
- 23 <u>the exclusive bargaining representative chosen under Section</u>
- 24 8.2 may request that any matter concerning wages, hours, or
- 25 terms and conditions of employment of court reporters shall
- 26 <u>be submitted to advisory, non-binding arbitration and that</u>
- 27 <u>the Supreme Court shall appoint arbitrators. Upon receiving</u>
- 28 <u>such a request, the Court shall appoint a panel of one or</u>
- 29 <u>more arbitrators and submit the matter to the panel for</u>
