Sec. 507Y. The Leukemia Treatment and Education 23 checkoff. The Department shall print on its standard 24 25 individual income tax form a provision indicating that if the taxpayer wishes to contribute to the Leukemia Treatment and 26 Education Fund, as authorized by this amendatory Act of the 27

93rd General Assembly, he or she may do so be stating the amount of the contribution (not less than \$1) on the return and that the contribution will reduce the taxpayer's refund or increase the amount of payment to accompany the return. Failure to remit any amount of increased payment shall reduce the contribution accordingly. This Section shall not apply to any amended return.

Sec. 509. Tax checkoff explanations. All individual 9 10 income tax return forms shall contain appropriate explanations and spaces to enable the taxpayers to designate 11 contributions to the following funds: the Child Abuse 12 Prevention Fund, to the Illinois Wildlife Preservation Fund 13 14 (as required by the Illinois Non-Game Wildlife Protection 15 Act), to the Alzheimer's Disease Research Fund (as required by the Alzheimer's Disease Research Act), to the Assistance 16 17 to the Homeless Fund (as required by this Act), to the Penny 18 Severns Breast and Cervical Cancer Research Fund, to the National World War II Memorial Fund, to the Prostate Cancer 19 20 Research Fund, the Multiple Sclerosis Assistance Fund, the 21 Leukemia Treatment and Education Fund, and to the Korean War 22 Veterans National Museum and Library Fund.

Each form shall contain a statement that the contributions will reduce the taxpayer's refund or increase the amount of payment to accompany the return. Failure to remit any amount of increased payment shall reduce the contribution accordingly.

If, on October 1 of any year, the total contributions to any one of the funds made under this Section do not equal \$100,000 or more, the explanations and spaces for designating contributions to the fund shall be removed from the individual income tax return forms for the following and all subsequent years and all subsequent contributions to the fund SB881 Enrolled
