- 1 AN ACT relating to schools.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 2-3.131 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.131 new)
- 7 Sec. 2-3.131. K-3 class size reduction grant program. A
- 8 <u>class size reduction grant program is hereby created. The</u>
- 9 program shall be implemented and administered by the State
- 10 Board of Education, which shall award grants from
- 11 <u>appropriations made for purposes of this Section to school</u>
- 12 <u>districts that meet the criteria established by this Section</u>
- for the award of those grants.
- 14 Grants shall be awarded pursuant to application. The
- 15 <u>form and manner of applications and the criteria for the</u>
- 16 <u>award of grants shall be prescribed by the State Board of</u>
- 17 <u>Education</u>. However, the grant criteria as so prescribed
- 18 shall provide that: (i) for the 2004-2005 school year, the
- 19 2005-2006 school year, the 2006-2007 school year, and the
- 20 <u>2007-2008</u> school year, only those schools that are on the
- 21 <u>State Board of Education Early Academic Warning List or the</u>
- 22 <u>academic watch list under Section 2-3.25d that maintain</u>
- 23 grades kindergarten through 3 shall be grant eligible; and
- 24 (ii) for the 2008-2009 school year and each year thereafter,
- 25 <u>all schools that maintain grades kindergarten through 3 shall</u>
- 26 <u>be grant eligible.</u>
- 27 <u>Grants awarded to eligible schools under this Section</u>
- 28 shall be used and applied by the schools to defray the costs
- 29 <u>and expenses of operating and maintaining classes with a</u>
- 30 class size of no more than 20 pupils in kindergarten for the
- 31 <u>2004-2005 school year, in kindergarten and first grade for</u>

- 1 the 2005-2006 school year, in kindergarten and first and
- 2 <u>second grades for the 2006-2007 school year, and in grades</u>
- 3 kindergarten through 3 for the 2007-2008 school year and each
- 4 <u>year thereafter.</u>
- 5 The State Board of Education shall adopt any rules,
- 6 consistent with the requirements of this Section, that are
- 7 necessary to implement and administer the K-3 class size
- 8 <u>reduction grant program.</u>
- 9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 10 becoming law.
