- 1 AN ACT concerning health benefit plans.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 352b as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/352b new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 352b. Flexible health plans.</u>
- 8 (a) The Illinois General Assembly finds that a
- 9 <u>significant proportion of the residents of this State are</u>
- 10 <u>unable to obtain affordable health insurance coverage. The</u>
- 11 General Assembly recognizes the need for individuals and
- 12 employers in this State to have the opportunity to choose
- 13 <u>health</u> insurance plans that are more affordable and flexible
- 14 than standard market policies of accident and health
- insurance and the need to increase the availability of health
- 16 <u>insurance coverage by authorizing the transaction of this</u>
- 17 type of plan or policy by carriers licensed to provide health
- 18 <u>insurance in this State. Therefore, it is the intent of the</u>
- 19 <u>Illinois General Assembly to expand the availability of</u>
- 20 <u>affordable and flexible health insurance options for</u>
- 21 <u>individuals</u> and employers by allowing health insurance

- 2 <u>"Health benefit plan" means any hospital or medical</u>
- 3 <u>expense-incurred policy</u>, hospital or medical service plan
- 4 <u>contract</u>, or <u>health maintenance organization subscriber</u>
- 5 <u>contract</u>.
- 6 "Health flex plan" means a health benefit plan offered by
- 7 <u>a carrier authorized to transact business in this State that,</u>
- 8 <u>either in whole or in part, does not provide State mandated</u>
- 9 <u>health benefits.</u>
- 10 <u>"State mandated health benefits" means coverage for</u>
- 11 specific health care services, benefits, or treatment
- 12 required by State law or rule, limitations or restrictions on
- 13 <u>deductibles</u>, <u>coinsurance</u>, <u>copayments</u>, <u>or any annual or</u>
- 14 <u>lifetime maximum benefit amounts, or inclusion of a specific</u>
- 15 <u>health care provider to be provided to a person covered under</u>
- 16 <u>a health benefit plan issued in the State of Illinois. "State</u>
- 17 <u>mandated health benefits" does not mean standard provisions</u>
- 18 <u>or rights required to be present in a health benefit plan</u>
- 19 pursuant to State law or regulations including, but not
- 20 <u>limited to, those contained in Article IV of the Health</u>
- 21 <u>Maintenance Organization Act, Sections 356b through 356L</u>,
- 22 Sections 356n through 356z.2, Section 367b, Section 367e,
- 23 <u>Section 367i, Section 367.2, and Section 370c of the Illinois</u>
- 24 <u>Insurance Code</u>.
- 25 (c) In addition to offering within this State health
- 26 <u>benefit plans that must contain State mandated health</u>
- 27 <u>benefits</u>, any carrier authorized to transact business in this
- 28 State shall be authorized to offer, as an option, a health
- flex plan beginning on January 1, 2004.
- 30 (d) In each sale of a health benefit plan in which the
- 31 proposed group has chosen a health flex plan, the carrier
- 32 shall:
- 33 (1) provide notice that identifies to the
- 34 policyholder the State mandated benefits not included in

1	the health flex plan. Such notice shall be provided by
2	the employer to each employee participating in the health
3	<pre>flex plan;</pre>
4	(2) provide to the policy holder a notice with the
5	following language in bold type:
6	"This health flex plan, either in whole or in part,

8	required in accident and health insurance policies in
9	Illinois. This health flex plan may provide a more
10	affordable health insurance policy for you, although, at
11	the same time, it may provide you with fewer health
12	benefits than those normally included as State mandated
13	health benefits in policies in Illinois.";
14	(3) provide to the policyholder a statement to be
15	signed acknowledging that the health flex plan being
16	purchased does not provide the State mandated health
17	benefits listed on the form; and
18	(4) maintain the signed notice to provide
19	information as may be needed by the Director of
20	Insurance.
21	(e) The Director may promulgate rules as necessary to
22	implement the provisions of this Section.
