AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1049

AMENDMENT NO. ____. Amend Senate Bill 1049, AS AMENDED, 2 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the 3 4 following:

5 "Section 5. The Park District Code is amended by adding Section 5-2e as follows: 6

(70 ILCS 1205/5-2e new)

Sec. 5-2e. Park district property within municipality 8 9 with recreation board or within a supervised recreation system; disconnection. Any territory of a park district that 10 is located within a municipality that has established a 11 recreation board under Section 11-95-3 of the Illinois 12 Municipal Code, or a supervised recreation system that levies 13 14 taxes for the establishment, conduct, and maintenance thereof, may be disconnected from the park district if the 15 affected land owners are levied a tax by both governmental 16 bodies for recreational services. A petition must be signed 17 by 10% of the owners of record of the land within the 18 territory proposed to be disconnected. The petition must 19 allege the facts in support of the disconnection. The 20 21 petition shall be filed with the municipal clerk. The corporate authorities of the municipality shall adopt an 22

1 ordinance that provides that the question of disconnection be submitted to the electors of the territory proposed to be 2 3 disconnected. 4 Upon adoption of the ordinance, the municipal clerk shall certify the ordinance and the question to the proper election 5 authorities, who shall submit the question to the electors of 6 the territory at an election in accordance with the general 7 8 election law. 9 The question cast at this election shall be in substantially the following form: 10 Shall (describe territory) be disconnected from 11 (name of park district) and the levy of any taxes by the 12 Park District be discontinued? 13 The votes shall be recorded as "Yes" or "No". 14 If a majority of the votes cast upon the question are in 15 favor of disconnection, the territory shall be disconnected 16 from the park district, the park district shall cease to 17 exercise its power or authority over the disconnected 18 19 territory, and the levy of any taxes (except for taxes levied pursuant to Section 3-7 for contracted indebtedness) by the 20 park district shall be discontinued. 21

22 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 23 becoming law.".
