AN ACT in relation to courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Clerks of Courts Act is amended by 5 changing Section 27.3b as follows:

6 (705 ILCS 105/27.3b) (from Ch. 25, par. 27.3b)

Sec. 27.3b. The clerk of court may accept payment of 7 8 fines, penalties, or costs by credit card or debit card approved by the clerk from an offender who has been convicted 9 of or placed on court supervision for a traffic offense, 10 petty offense, ordinance offense, or misdemeanor or who has 11 been convicted of a felony offense. The clerk of the circuit 12 13 court may accept credit card payments over the Internet for fines, penalties, or costs from offenders on voluntary 14 electronic pleas of quilty in minor traffic and conservation 15 16 offenses to satisfy the requirement of written pleas of guilty as provided in Illinois Supreme Court Rule 529. 17 The 18 clerk of the court may also accept payment of statutory fees by a credit card or debit card. The clerk of the court may 19 20 also accept the credit card or debit card for the cash deposit of bail bond fees up to \$300. 21

The Clerk of the circuit court is authorized to enter 22 into contracts with credit card or debit card companies 23 approved by the clerk and to pay those companies 24 fees 25 normally charged by those companies for allowing the clerk of the circuit court to accept their credit cards or debit cards 26 27 in payment as authorized herein. Where the offender pays fines, penalties, or costs by credit card or debit card, or 28 anyone paying statutory fees of the circuit court clerk or 29 the posting of cash bail, the clerk shall collect a service 30 fee of up to \$5 or the amount charged to the clerk for use of 31

its services by the credit card or debit card issuer. This
service fee shall be in addition to any other fines,
penalties, or costs.
