- 4 Section 5. The Tax Collection Suit Act is amended by
- 5 changing Section 1 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 1. At the request of any officer or agency charged
- 8 with the responsibility of collecting any tax that is imposed
- 9 by this State or that is collectible by this State on behalf
- of a political subdivision thereof, the Attorney General of
- 11 this State shall may bring suit, in the name of this State or
- in the name of the officer or agency on whose behalf the suit
- is brought, in the appropriate court of any other state, to
- 14 collect any tax legally due to this State or to the political
