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AN ACT concerning employment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Minimum Wage Law is amended by changing
Section 7 as follows:

6 (820 ILCS 105/7) (from Ch. 48, par. 1007)

7 Sec. 7. The Director or his <u>or her</u> authorized
8 representatives have the authority to:

(a) Investigate and gather data regarding the wages, 9 hours and other conditions and practices of employment in any 10 industry subject to this Act, and may enter and inspect such 11 places and such records (and make such transcriptions 12 13 thereof) at reasonable times during regular business hours, not including lunch time at a restaurant, question such 14 employees, and investigate such facts, conditions, practices 15 16 or matters as he may deem necessary or appropriate to determine whether any person has violated any provision of 17 18 this Act, or which may aid in the enforcement of this Act.

(b) Require from any employer full and correct statements and reports in writing, including sworn statements, at such times as the Director may deem necessary, of the wages, hours, names, addresses, and other information pertaining to his employees as he may deem necessary for the enforcement of this Act.
