- 4 Section 5. The Liquor Control Act of 1934 is amended by
- 5 changing Section 1-3.02 as follows:
- 6 (235 ILCS 5/1-3.02) (from Ch. 43, par. 95.02)
- 7 Sec. 1-3.02. "Spirits" means any beverage that which
- 8 contains alcohol obtained by distillation, mixed with water
- 9 or other substance in solution, and includes brandy, rum,
- 10 whiskey, gin, or other spirituous liquors, and such liquors
- 11 when rectified, blended or otherwise mixed with alcohol or
- 12 other substances.
