- 4 Section 5. The Attorney General Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 6.6 as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 6.6. Office of Civil Rights.</u>
- 8 <u>(a) There is hereby created within the criminal division</u>
- 9 of the Office of the Attorney General an Office of Civil
- 10 Rights, which is empowered to investigate official misconduct
- 11 by prosecutors as provided in this Section. The Office of
- 12 <u>Civil Rights shall have the duty to investigate and bring</u>
- criminal charges against a prosecutor who does not carry out
- 14 <u>his or her official duties by failing to prosecute a case</u>
- 15 when there is substantial evidence warranting the prosecution
- of the case.
- 17 (b) The Office of Civil Rights may initiate
- 18 <u>investigations of prosecutors under this Section and may</u>
- 19 <u>respond to allegations of prosecutorial misconduct by private</u>
