- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2008)
- 8 Sec. 8. <u>Licensure without examination</u>. The Department
- 9 may, in its discretion, license as a pharmacist, without
- 10 examination, on payment of the required fee, an applicant who
- is so licensed under the laws of another U.S. jurisdiction or
- 12 another country, if the requirements for licensure in the
- other jurisdiction in which the applicant was licensed, were,
- 14 at the date of his licensure deemed by the Board to be
