- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 10-20.7 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.7) (from Ch. 122, par. 10-20.7)
- 7 Sec. 10-20.7. Appoint teachers and fix salaries. To
- 8 appoint all teachers and fix the amount of their salaries,
- 9 subject to limitations set forth in this Act.
- 10 In fixing salaries of certificated employees, school
- 11 boards shall make no discrimination on account of sex and
- 12 there shall be no loss in salary because of jury duty or
- 13 because such employee, pursuant to subpoena issued by the
- 14 clerk of a court and served on such employee, attends as a
- 15 witness upon trial or to have his or her deposition taken in
- 16 any school related matter pending in court, except that the
- 17 board may make a deduction equal to the amount received for
- 18 such jury duty or for per diem fees which the employee is
- 19 entitled to receive for complying with such subpoena.
- 20 Certified employees may be paid full salary by the board when
- 21 in the active service of this State, under orders of the
- 22 Commander-in-Chief, as members of the Illinois National Guard
- or Illinois Naval Militia, provided that the board may deduct
- 24 from such salary any amounts received for such State service.
- 25 A school board may at any time after January 1 employ
- 26 teachers for the school year beginning on the following July
- 27 1.
- 28 <u>A school board may contract with a private business</u>
- 29 <u>entity for qualified substitute teachers to be furnished to</u>
- 30 <u>its schools, provided that the school board remains</u>
- 31 <u>responsible for the selection and retention criteria for and</u>

- 1 supervision of the substitute teachers furnished to its
- 2 schools by the private business entity.
