- 1 AN ACT concerning vehicles.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 3-663 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-663 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 3-663. Special registration plate for a councilman,</u>
- 8 <u>alderman, or village trustee.</u>
- 9 <u>(a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees</u>
- 10 and applications made in the form prescribed by the
- 11 <u>Secretary, may issue special registration plates to</u>
- 12 <u>councilmen</u>, aldermen, and village trustees.
- 13 The special plates issued under this Section shall be
- 14 <u>affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division or</u>
- 15 motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than
- 16 <u>8,000 pounds</u>.
- 17 <u>Plates issued under this Section shall expire according</u>
- to the multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of
- 19 <u>this Code</u>.
- 20 (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be
- 21 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Appropriate
- 22 <u>documentation</u>, as <u>determined</u> by the <u>Secretary</u>, shall
- 23 <u>accompany each application.</u>
- 24 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged
- 25 <u>a \$15 fee for original issuance in addition to the</u>
- 26 <u>appropriate registration fee</u>. This additional fee shall be
- 27 <u>deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate</u>
- 28 Fund, to be used by the Secretary to help defray the
- 29 <u>administrative processing costs.</u>
- For each registration renewal period, a \$2 fee, in
- 31 <u>addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be</u>

- charged. This additional fee shall be deposited into the 1
- Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. 2
