SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/7-3-6.2 new

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that the owner or owners of a split lot that is located in and governed by 2 municipalities or that is governed by a municipality and a county may disconnect a portion of the lot so that a single municipality or county governs the entire lot.

AN ACT concerning municipalities.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding
Section 7-3-6.2 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/7-3-6.2 new)

Sec. 7-3-6.2. Split lots. Notwithstanding any other 7 provision of this Code, the owner or owners of record of a 8 split residential lot may disconnect a portion of the lot so 9 that a single municipality or county governs the entire lot. 10 The owner or owners seeking to disconnect a portion of a split 11 lot from a municipality must petition the court in the manner 12 provided in Section 7-3-6 of this Code. 13 For the purposes of this Section, "split lot" means a 14 15 single residential lot that is located in and governed by 2

16 <u>municipalities or that is governed by a municipality and a</u> 17 <u>county.</u>
