- 1 AN ACT concerning community-integrated living

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- 5 Section 5. The Community-Integrated Living Arrangements
- 6 Licensure and Certification Act is amended by changing Section
- 7 2 as follows:
- 8 (210 ILCS 135/2) (from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 1702)
- 9 Sec. 2. Purpose. The purpose of this Act is to promote the
- 10 operation of community-integrated living arrangements for the
- 11 supervision of persons with mental illness and persons with a
- developmental disability by licensing community mental health
- or developmental services agencies to provide an array of
- 14 community-integrated living arrangements for such individuals.
- 15 These community-integrated living arrangements are intended to
- 16 promote independence in daily living and economic
- 17 self-sufficiency. The licensed community mental health or
- developmental services agencies in turn shall be required to
- 19 certify to the Department that the programs and placements
- 20 provided in the community-integrated living arrangements
- 21 comply with this Act, the Mental Health and Developmental
- 22 Disabilities Code, and applicable Department rules and
- 23 regulations.
