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AN ACT concerning vehicles.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 3-806.3 as follows:

Sec. 3-806.3. Senior Citizens.

Commencing with the 2001 registration year and extending 8 through the 2003 registration year, the registration fee paid 9 by any vehicle owner who has claimed and received a grant under 10 the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief 11 and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act or who is the spouse of such 12 a person shall be \$24 instead of the fee otherwise provided in 13 14 this Code for passenger cars displaying standard multi year 15 registration plates issued under Section 3 414.1, motor vehicles displaying special registration plates issued under 16 17 Section 3 616, motor vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(a) and recreational vehicles 18 registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(b). 19 20 Widows and widowers of claimants shall also be entitled to this reduced registration fee for the registration year in which the 21 claimant was eligible. 22

Commencing with the 2004 registration year and extending 23 through the 2005 registration year, the registration fee paid 24 25 by any vehicle owner who has claimed and received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief 26 and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act or who is the spouse of such 27 28 a person shall be \$24 instead of the fee otherwise provided in 29 this Code for passenger cars displaying standard multi-year 30 registration plates issued under Section 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special registration plates issued under 31 Section 3-616, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-624, 3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 32

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3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, or 3-651, motor vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(a), and recreational vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(b). Widows and widowers of claimants shall also be entitled to this reduced registration fee for the registration year in which the claimant was eligible.

7 Commencing with the 2006 registration year, the 8 registration fee paid by any vehicle owner who has claimed and 9 received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act or who is 10 11 the spouse of such a person shall be \$24 instead of the fee otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars displaying 12 13 standard multi-year registration plates issued under Section 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special registration plates 14 issued under Section 3-616, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-624, 3-625, 15 16 <u>3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, 3-651, or</u> 17 3-806.4, motor vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(a), and recreational vehicles registered 18 at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(b). Widows and 19 20 widowers of claimants shall also be entitled to this reduced registration fee for the registration year in which the 21 claimant was eligible. 22

23 No more than one reduced registration fee under this Section shall be allowed during any 12 month period based on 24 25 the primary eligibility of any individual, whether such reduced 26 registration fee is allowed to the individual or to the spouse, 27 widow or widower of such individual.
