1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Ticket Scalping Act is amended by changing

 Section 4 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 375/4) (from Ch. 121 1/2, par. 157.35)
- Sec. 4. Nothing contained in this Act was ever intended to prohibit nor shall ever be deemed to prohibit a ticket seller, with consent of the sponsor of <u>any such</u> baseball game, football game, hockey game, theatre entertainment or other amusement, from collecting a reasonable service charge, in addition to the printed box office ticket price, from a ticket purchaser in
