**A BILL FOR**

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of  
5 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the  
6 objects and purposes named, are appropriated from the General  
7 Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender to  
8 meet its ordinary and contingent expenses.

15 those amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the  
16 objects and purposes names, are appropriated from the General  
17 Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender  
18 for expenses related to federally assisted programs to work  
19 on systemic sentencing issues appeals cases to which the  
20 agency is appointed, provide statewide training and services  
21 to Illinois Public Defenders, and to enhance the capability  
22 of public defenders in rural counties to effectively  
23 represent their clients in appropriate cases, making  
24 available to them expert witnesses and investigative  
25 services.

30       Section 15. The amount of \$3,141,784, or so much of that  
31 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital

1 Litigation Trust Fund to the Office of the State Appellate  
2 Defender for expenses incurred in providing assistance to  
3 trial attorneys under item (c) (5) of Section 10 of the State  
4 Appellate Defender Act.

5 Section 20 The amount, \$157,000, or so much of that  
6 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General  
7 Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender  
8 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Expungement  
9 Program.

10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
11 2004.
