SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

210 ILCS 135/12 new

Amends the Community-Integrated Living Arrangements Licensure and Certification Act. Requires the Department of Human Services to implement a 3-year pilot project in Will County or southern Cook County for the operation of 2 CILA homes for adolescents diagnosed with autism. Effective July 1, 2004.

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AN ACT concerning health facilities.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Community-Integrated Living Arrangements
Licensure and Certification Act is amended by adding Section 12
as follows:

7 (210 ILCS 135/12 new	r)
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8 <u>Sec. 12. Pilot Project; CILAs for adolescents diagnosed</u>
9 with autism.

(a) The Department shall implement a pilot project for the 10 operation of 2 community-integrated living arrangement homes 11 for adolescents who have been diagnosed with autism and who are 12 at least 13 years of age and not more than 18 years of age. The 13 homes shall be located in Will County or southern Cook County. 14 15 The homes shall operate 7 days per week and shall be staffed 24 hours per day. The homes shall feature maximum family 16 17 involvement based on a service and support agreement signed by the adolescent's family and the provider. The duration of the 18 19 pilot project shall be 3 years.

20 <u>(b) Each home must include on its staff a behavior</u> 21 <u>therapist. The provider shall ensure that the staff at each</u> 22 <u>home receives appropriate training in matters that include, but</u> 23 <u>need not be limited to, the following: behavior analysis, skill</u> 24 <u>training, and other methodologies of teaching such as discreet</u> 25 <u>trial and picture exchange communication system.</u>

26 (c) The homes shall provide therapeutic and other support 27 services to the adolescents being served there. The therapeutic 28 curriculum shall be based on the principles of applied behavior 29 analysis.

30 <u>(d) The Department shall adopt rules as necessary to</u> 31 <u>implement this Section.</u>

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
