Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning school bus safety.

1 AN ACT with regard to vehicles.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 12-803 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/12-803) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 12-803)
- 7 Sec. 12-803. (a) Each school bus shall be equipped with a
- 8 stop signal arm on the driver's side of the school bus that may
- 9 be operated either manually or mechanically. For each school
- 10 bus manufactured on and after September 1, 1992, the stop
- 11 signal arm shall be an octagon shaped semaphore that conforms
- to 49 C.F.R. 571.131, "SCHOOL BUS PEDESTRIAN SAFETY DEVICES",
- 13 S5.1 through S5.5.
- 14 (b) Each school bus manufactured <u>before</u> prior to September
- 15 1, 1992 shall be equipped with a stop signal arm that conforms
- 16 to standards promulgated by the Department.
