# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by 5 changing Section 2-1702 as follows:

6 (735 ILCS 5/2-1702) (from Ch. 110, par. 2-1702)

7 (Text of Section WITHOUT the changes made by P.A. 89-7,
8 which has been held unconstitutional)

9 Sec. 2-1702. <u>Economic loss; non-economic loss.</u>
 10 <u>Economic/Non-Economic Loss.</u> As used in this Part:

11 (a) "Economic loss" means all pecuniary harm for which12 damages are recoverable.

(b) "Non-economic loss" means loss of consortium and all nonpecuniary harm for which damages are recoverable, including, without limitation, damages for pain and suffering, inconvenience, disfigurement, and physical impairment.
