1 AN ACT concerning business transactions.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
  Practices Act is amended by adding Section 2QQ as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2QQ new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 2QQ. Internet service; cancellation.</u>
- 8 (a) As used in this Section:
- 9 "Internet service provider" means a person who provides a
- 10 <u>service that combines computer processing</u>, information
- 11 storage, protocol conversion, and routing with transmission to
- 12 <u>enable a consumer to access Internet content and services.</u>
- 13 (b) This Section applies only to agreements under which an
- 14 <u>Internet service provider provides service to consumers for a</u>
- 15 <u>one-year term that is automatically renewed for another</u>
- one-year term unless a consumer cancels the service.
- (c) An Internet service provider must give any consumer who
- is an Illinois resident the following: (1) at least 30 days'
- 19 advance notice of the annual service renewal date, which notice
- 20 <u>shall include instructions that the consumer may follow to</u>
- 21 <u>cancel the service at the Internet service provider's web site;</u>
- 22 <u>and (2) a secure method at the Internet service provider's web</u>
- 23 <u>site that the consumer may use to cancel the service, which</u>
- 24 <u>method shall not require the consumer to make a telephone call</u>
- 25 <u>or send U.S. Postal Service mail to effectuate the</u>
- 26 cancellation.
- 27 (d) A person who violates this Section commits an unlawful
- 28 practice within the meaning of this Act.
