1 AN ACT concerning business transactions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
 Practices Act is amended by adding Section 2QQ as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 505/2QQ new)
- 7 Sec. 200. Internet service; cancellation.
- 8 (a) As used in this Section:
- 9 <u>"Internet service provider" means a person who provides a</u>
 10 service that combines computer processing, information
- 11 storage, protocol conversion, and routing with transmission to
- 12 enable a consumer to access Internet content and services.
- 13 (b) This Section applies only to agreements under which an
- 14 <u>Internet service provider provides service to consumers, for</u>
- 15 <u>home and personal use</u>, for a one-year term that is
- 16 <u>automatically renewed for another one-year term unless a</u>
- consumer cancels the service.
- 18 (c) An Internet service provider must give a consumer who
- is an Illinois resident the following: (1) a secure method at
- 20 <u>the Internet service provider's web site that the consumer may</u>
- 21 <u>use to cancel the service</u>, which method shall not require the
- 22 <u>consumer to make a telephone call or send U.S. Postal Service</u>
- 23 <u>mail to effectuate the cancellation; and (2) instructions that</u>
- 24 the consumer may follow to cancel the service at the Internet
- 25 <u>service provider's web site.</u>
- 26 (d) A person who violates this Section commits an unlawful
- 27 practice within the meaning of this Act.
