AN ACT concerning public health.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Food Handling Regulation Enforcement Act is
 amended by adding Section 3.1 as follows:
- 6 (410 ILCS 625/3.1 new)
- 7 Sec. 3.1. Potluck events.
- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "potluck event" means an event
 9 that meets all of the following conditions:
 - (1) People are gathered to share food at the event.
- 11 <u>(2) There is no compensation provided to people for</u> 12 bringing food to the event.
- 13 <u>(3) There is no charge for any food or beverage</u> 14 provided at the event.
- 15 (4) The event is not conducted for commercial purposes.
 (5) It is generally understood by the participants at
 the event that neither the food nor the facilities have
 been inspected by the State or a local certified public
 health department.
 - (6) The event is not held on public property.

21 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, neither the 22 Department of Public Health nor the health department of a unit 23 of local government may regulate the serving of food that is brought to a potluck event sponsored by a group of individuals 24 or a religious, charitable, or nonprofit organization by 25 26 individuals attending the potluck event for consumption at the potluck event. Individuals who are not members of a group or 27 28 organization sponsoring a potluck event may attend the potluck event and consume the food at the event. No fee may be charged 29 30 for admission to a potluck event that is exempt from regulation under this Section, nor may food be sold at a potluck event 31 32 that is exempt from regulation under this Section.
