

## 93RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2003 and 2004

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

70 ILCS 3705/7.3 new 70 ILCS 3710/5.2 new 70 ILCS 3715/6c new 70 ILCS 3720/2.5 new

Amends the Public Water District Act, the Water Service District Act, the Water Authorities Act, and the Water Commission Act of 1985. Requires a public water district, water service district, water authority, or water commission that issues a boil order or any other warning concerning the potability or safety of water to immediately give written notification to any county health department that serves an area subject to the order or warning. Requires the notification to include the estimated duration of the warning or order and the geographic area covered by the order or warning. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Public Water District Act is amended by adding Section 7.3 as follows:
- 6 (70 ILCS 3705/7.3 new)
- Sec. 7.3. Boil order or other warning; notification of 7 8 county health department required. If a public water district issues a boil order or any other warning concerning the 9 potability or safety of water, the district must immediately 10 give written notification to any county health department that 11 serves an area subject to the order or warning. The 12 notification must include the estimated duration of the order 13 or warning and the geographic area covered by the order or 14 15 warning.
- Section 10. The Water Service District Act is amended by adding Section 5.2 as follows:
- 18 (70 ILCS 3710/5.2 new)
- Sec. 5.2. Boil order or other warning; notification of 19 20 county health department required. If a water service district 21 issues a boil order or any other warning concerning the potability or safety of water, the district must immediately 22 23 give written notification to any county health department that 24 serves an area subject to the order or warning. The notification must include the estimated duration of the order 25 26 or warning and the geographic area covered by the order or 27 warning.
- Section 15. The Water Authorities Act is amended by adding Section 6c as follows:

Sec. 6c. Boil order or other warning; notification of county health department required. If a water authority issues a boil order or any other warning concerning the potability or safety of water, the authority must immediately give written notification to any county health department that serves an area subject to the order or warning. The notification must include the estimated duration of the order or warning and the geographic area covered by the order or warning.

- Section 20. The Water Commission Act of 1985 is amended by adding Section 2.5 as follows:
- 12 (70 ILCS 3720/2.5 new)
- Sec. 2.5. Boil order or other warning; notification of 13 14 county health department required. If a water commission issues a boil order or any other warning concerning the potability or 15 safety of water, the commission must immediately give written 16 17 notification to any county health department that serves an area subject to the order or warning. The notification must 18 include the estimated duration of the order or warning and the 19 geographic area covered by the order or warning. 20
- 21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 22 becoming law.
