Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

1 AN ACT in relation to vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing

 Section 11-500 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/11-500) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-500)
- Sec. 11-500. Definitions. For the purposes of interpreting 7 Sections 6-206.1 and 6-208.1 of this Code, "first offender" 8 means shall mean any person who has not had a previous 9 conviction or court assigned supervision for violating Section 10 11-501, or a similar provision of a local ordinance, or a 11 conviction in any other state for a violation of driving while 12 under the influence or a similar offense where the cause of 13 14 action is the same or substantially similar to this Code or any 15 person who has not had a driver's license suspension for violating Section 11-501.1 within 5 years prior to the date of 16 17 the current offense, except in cases where the driver submitted to chemical testing resulting in an alcohol concentration of 18 19 0.08 or more, or any amount of a drug, substance, or compound in such person's blood or urine resulting from the unlawful use 20 or consumption of cannabis listed in the Cannabis Control Act, 21 a controlled substance listed in the Illinois Controlled 22 23 Substances Act, or an intoxicating compound listed in the Use of Intoxicating Compounds Act and was subsequently found not 24 25 guilty of violating Section 11-501, or a similar provision of a 26 local ordinance.
