Makes appropriations to the University of Illinois for its FY05 ordinary and contingent expenses. Effective July 1, 2004.

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
5	as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
6	purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General
7	Revenue Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
8	Illinois to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the
9	University of Illinois, including payment to the University
10	for personal services and related costs incurred during the
11	fiscal year:
12	For Personal Services\$611,035,700
13	Included in the above amount is a sum for salaries accrued
14	but unpaid to academic personnel for personal services
15	rendered during the academic year 2003-2004.
16	For State Contributions to Social
17	Security/Medicare8,937,100

Section 15. The sum of \$1,744,600, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service Institute and paying the expenses and providing the facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment

to the University for personal services and related costs.

Section 20. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in accordance with Public Act 91-83.

Section 30. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Tobacco Settlement Recovery Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for the ordinary and contingent expenses for technology transfer.

Section 35. The sum of \$52,953, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004, from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 4, Section 30 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois to plan for all aspects of construction and to acquire and develop land, including demolition, landscaping, site improvements, extension and modification of campus utility systems, relocation of programs, and such other expenses as may be necessary to

1 construct a College of Medicine building in Chicago.

The sum of \$18,638,542, or so much thereof 2 Section 40. as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004, 3 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in 4 Article 4, Section 35 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated 5 from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of 6 the University of Illinois to construct an education and 7 research facility for the College of Medicine in Chicago, 8 including planning, land acquisition, demolition, 9 10 construction, remodeling, landscaping, site improvements, equipment, extension or modification of campus utility 11 12 systems, relocation of programs, and such expenses as may be necessary to complete the facility. 13

Section 45. The sum of \$44,997, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004, from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 4, Section 45 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the University of Illinois for planning, construction, and equipment for a computer science in engineering facility.

The sum of \$12,291,197, or so much thereof 21 Section 50. as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004, 22 23 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 4, Section 50 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated 24 from the Capital Development Fund to the University of 25 Illinois at Springfield for constructing a classroom and 26 office building, in addition to funds previously 27 28 appropriated.

Section 55. The sum of \$814,444, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,

- 3 from the Capital Development Fund to the University of

- 6 Section 60. The sum of \$446,170, or so much thereof as
- 7 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,
- 8 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in
- 9 Article 4, Section 60 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated
- 10 from the Capital Development Fund to the University of
- 11 Illinois for digitalization infrastructure for WILL-TV
- 12 (Urbana-Champaign).
- 13 Section 65. The sum of \$814,444, or so much thereof as
- 14 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,
- 15 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in
- 16 Article 4, Section 65 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated
- 17 from the Capital Development Fund to the University of
- 18 Illinois for digitalization infrastructure for WILL-TV
- 19 (Urbana-Champaign).
- Section 70. The sum of \$13,916,332, or so much thereof
- as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,
- 22 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in
- 23 Article 4, Section 70 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated
- from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of
- 25 the University of Illinois to plan and construct an Education
- and Research facility for the College of Medicine in Chicago,
- 27 including planning, land acquisition, demolition,
- 28 construction, remodeling, landscaping, site improvements,
- 29 equipment, extension or modification of campus utility
- 30 systems, relocation of programs, and such expenses as may be

in addition to funds previously appropriated.

The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof 2 Section 75. as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004, 3 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in 4 Article 4, Section 75 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated 5 from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of 6 7 the University of Illinois to plan and construct a Classroom and Office Building at the Springfield Campus and related 8 utility systems, including planning, 9 land acquisition, 10 demolition, construction, remodeling, landscaping, improvements, equipment, extension or modification of campus 11 12 utility systems, and such expenses as may be necessary to complete the facility. This reappropriation is in addition 13 to funds previously appropriated. 14

Section 80. The sum of \$13,761,948, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 2004, from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 4, Section 80 of Public Act 93-90 is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for all costs associated with the space needs of the Department of Natural Resources, Illinois Natural History Survey Division and State Water Survey Division on the campus of the University of Illinois in Champaign, including construction, capital facilities, planning, relocation, renovation and rehabilitation, mechanical systems, materials, services, and all other costs required to complete the work.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 29 2004.
