WHEREAS, Diabetes is the sixth leading cause of death in Illinois, and it is the number one cause of heart disease, stroke, blindness, amputation, and kidney disease; and

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

- 5 WHEREAS, Diabetes is more prevalent in underserved 6 populations; African Americans and Hispanics have nearly twice 7 the incidence of diabetes as whites; in Illinois, diabetes is 8 more prevalent among persons 45 years of age and older than it 9 is in the United States overall; and
- WHEREAS, In Illinois, diabetes costs for Fiscal Year 2004
  will exceed \$6.5 billion; a savings of over \$2 billion can be
  achieved by improving diabetes control through education and
  proper treatment; and
- WHEREAS, Diabetes self-management and awareness about the disease are necessary elements in keeping diabetes under control and reducing complications; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Through increased knowledge of diabetes and 18 improved patient care of those diagnosed, the lives of 19 individuals living with a disease that has no cure can be 20 improved; therefore, be it
