Miller completed basic training and the 14 infantryman's Advanced Individual Training (AIT) at Fort Benning, Georgia; upon completion of basic training and AIT, 15 he attended the Army basic airborne course and the 75th 16 17 Ranger Regiment's Ranger Indoctrination Program (RIP); he was 18 then assigned as a rifleman and squad automatic weapons gunner to 3rd squad, 3rd Platoon Alpha Co., 1st Battalion, 19 20 75th Ranger Regiment; while assigned to the Rangers, he 21 participated in numerous training and combat operations, 22 including Operation Enduring Freedom from December 2001 to April 2002 and Operation Iraqi Freedom from March 2003 to 23 April 2003; additionally, his unit participated in the rescue 24 mission of Jessica Lynch; and 25

Miller was the recipient of numerous 27 awards, including the Covered Ranger Tab, Basic Parachutist's 28 Badge, the Army Commendation Medal with one oak leaf cluster, 29 the National Defense Service Medal, the Army Service Ribbon, 30 the Combat Infantryman's Badge, and the Expert Infantryman's 31 Badge; and
