- 14 students and later became assistant director of nursing

- of the St. Francis Senior Saints; she was also a member of
- 18 St. Mark's Catholic Church in Peoria, the St. Francis
- 19 Auxiliary, the St. Francis Advisor Committee, the Catholic
- 20 Women's League, and the Visiting Nurse Association; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Mrs. Schmitt was a member of the Illinois
- 22 Township Officials, West Peoria Residents Association, West
- Peoria Democrats, and Peoria County Democrats; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Mrs. Schmitt was preceded in death by 3
- 25 stepsons; 4 sisters; 3 brothers; and one step-grandchild; she
- is survived by one daughter, Kathy (and Alex) Garcia; 2 sons,
