14 activist for various causes and public officials including
15 Senator Collins; and

17 as a young woman through the Elite Sub-Debs, Miss Bronze
18 America Club, Englewood Circle Saroines, Junior Auxiliary,
19 Las Chatamas Club, and as a volunteer for Christmas Seals;

22 through serving as a volunteer secretary to Father George
23 Clements' Holy Angels, Ladies for Lunch Senior Group, Dolton
24 Seniors, Midway Gardens Seniors, Department on Aging

26 Chicago Senior Citizen Hall of Fame Award on May 2, 2002; and

28 listener, dependable, free-thinking, high-spirited, outgoing,
29 friendly, loving of others, and socially active; and
