SENATE RESOLUTION

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that there is created a Senate Task Force on Illinois Mobile Homes for the purpose of examining the special needs and relationships between home communities, home owners, park owners, and mobile home retailers and manufacturers; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Senate Task Force on Illinois Mobile Homes shall consist of the following members:

(1) A chairperson who is a member of the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate;

(2) 4 members of the General Assembly, 2 of whom are appointed by the President of the Senate and 2 of whom are appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate;

(3) 2 members from the Mobile Homeowners Association of Illinois appointed by its president;

(4) 2 members from the Illinois Manufactured Housing Association appointed by its president;

(5) 2 members from the Illinois Housing Institute appointed by its president;

(6) 2 staff members from the Illinois Department of Public Health appointed by its Director; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the members shall serve on a voluntary basis and shall be responsible for any costs associated with their participation in the Senate Task Force; and be it further

RESOLVED, That all members of the Senate Task Force shall be considered to be members with voting rights, that a quorum of the Senate Task Force shall consist of a simple majority of the members of the Senate Task Force, and that all actions and recommendations of the Senate Task Force be approved by a simple majority of the members of the Senate Task Force; and be it further

1 RESOLVED, That the Senate Task Force on Illinois Mobile
2 Homes shall meet at the call of the chairperson and shall
3 summarize its findings and recommendations in a report to the
4 General Assembly no later than January 1, 2005.
