## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-663 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for issuance of Paratrooper license plates, at an additional initial charge of \$15 and an additional renewal charge of \$2 with eligibility requirements to be determined by the Secretary of State. Provides that the \$15 additional initial charge and the \$2 renewal charge shall go to the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund.

1 AN ACT in relation to vehicles.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Section 3-663 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-663 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 3-663. Paratrooper license plates.</u>
- (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the 8 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications 9 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may 10 issue Paratrooper license plates to residents of Illinois who 11 meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of 12 State. The special Paratrooper plate issued under this Section 13 shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first 14 15 division and motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall 16 expire according to the staggered multi-year procedure 17

established by Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

- 19 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The 20 21 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with 22 Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to 23 designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of 24 Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the 25 26 eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under 27 28 Section 3-412.
  - (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$15 fee for original issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. This additional fee shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. For each registration renewal

- period, a \$2 fee, in addition to the appropriate registration 1
- 2 fee, shall be charged and shall be deposited into the Secretary
- 3 of State Special License Plate Fund.
