Previously dispensed prescription drugs. 16 17 (a) A person may not sell, redistribute, or otherwise dispense any prescription drug that has previously been sold, 18 distributed, or otherwise dispensed by a pharmacist. A person 19 20 who violates this subsection (a) is subject to an injunction as provided in Section 4 and criminal penalties as provided in 21 Section 5. 22 (b) The Department of Public Health shall establish and 23
