13	any provision of Sections 3.1 through 3.21 or Section 16.10.

16	Sec. 16.10. Previously dispensed prescription drugs.
17	(a) A person may not sell or redistribute any prescription
18	drug that has previously been sold and distributed. A person
19	who violates this subsection (a) is subject to an injunction as
20	provided in Section 4 and criminal penalties as provided in
21	Section 5.
22	(b) The Department of Public Health shall establish and
23	administer a program under which a local law enforcement

1	authority or local public health office shall (i) take
2	possession of prescription drugs that have been returned
3	pursuant to an injunction issued in response to a violation of
4	subsection (a) or confiscated pursuant to a prosecution for a

6	drugs according to standards adopted by the Department.
7	(c) This Section does not apply to any pharmacist or
8	pharmacy that is regulated under the Pharmacy Practice Act of
0	1007
