SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

50 ILCS 705/10.15 new 50 ILCS 705/10.20 new

Amends the Illinois Police Training Act. Subject to appropriation, requires the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board to initiate, administer, and conduct training courses for permanent police officers, part-time police officers, and recruits concerning (i) suicide response and (ii) domestic violence response.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Police Training Act is amended by adding Sections 10.15 and 10.20 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 705/10.15 new)

7 Sec. 10.15. Suicide response training. Subject to appropriation, the Board shall initiate, administer, and 8 conduct a training course for permanent police officers, 9 part-time police officers, and recruits concerning the methods 10 and clinical aspects related to officer response to suicidal 11 persons. The course shall include training in crisis incident 12 stress debriefing, risk assessment, and death notification 13 skills. The Board shall issue a certificate for those police 14 15 officers and recruits who successfully complete the training.

Sec. 10.20. Domestic violence response training. Subject to appropriation, the Board shall initiate, administer, and conduct a training course for permanent police officers, part-time police officers, and recruits concerning domestic violence situations, offenses related to domestic violence, and protection orders and consent agreements issued or approved under the Illinois Domestic Violence Act of 1986. The Board shall issue a certificate for those police officers and recruits who successfully complete the training.
