SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Creates the Department of Health Professional Regulation Act. Creates the Department of Health Professional Regulation as a department of State government. Transfers to the Department of Health Professional Regulation all of the functions of the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation in connection with specified professional regulatory Acts concerning the provision of health care. Provides for the transfer of employees, books and records, and unexpended appropriations from the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation to the Department of Health Professional Regulation. Contains other provisions to implement the transfer of functions from the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation to the Department of Health Professional Regulation. Amends the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois and various professional regulatory Acts to make conforming changes. Effective July 1, 2005.

AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
Department of Health Professional Regulation Act.

Section 5. Department of Health Professional Regulation.

7 (a) The Department of Health Professional Regulation is8 created.

9 (b) The Department of Health Professional Regulation shall 10 be under the direction of the Director of Health Professional 11 Regulation, as provided in the Civil Administrative Code of 12 Illinois. The Director may create administrative units within 13 the Department and may assign functions, powers, duties, and 14 personnel as necessary to carry out the functions and 15 responsibilities vested in the Department.

16 (c) For purposes of the Successor Agency Act and for 17 purposes of Section 9b of the State Finance Act, the Department 18 of Health Professional Regulation is the successor agency to 19 the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation with 20 respect to the functions transferred to the Department of 21 Health Professional Regulation under this Act.

Section 10. Functions transferred.

23 (a) All of the functions of the Department of Financial and 24 Professional Regulation under each of the following Acts, and 25 all of the powers, duties, rights, and responsibilities, including funding mechanisms, associated with or related to 26 27 those functions and vested by law in the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation or in any office, 28 29 division, council, committee, bureau, board, commission, officer, employee, or other individual or entity associated 30 with the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, 31

6 (b) The functions, powers, duties, rights, and responsibilities transferred to the Department of Health 7 Professional Regulation under this Act are not affected by this 8 9 Act, except that they shall be carried out by the Department of Health Professional Regulation on and after the effective date 10 11 of this Act.

Section 15. Representation on boards or other entities. 12 When any provision of an Act provides for the membership of the 13 14 Secretary of Financial and Professional Regulation on any 15 council, commission, board, or other entity in connection with transferred to 16 any function the Department of Health Professional Regulation under this Act, the Director of Health 17 18 Professional Regulation, or the Director's designee, shall 19 serve in that place. If more than one such person is required by law to serve on any council, commission, board, or other 20 entity, then an equivalent number of representatives of the 21 Department of Health Professional Regulation shall so serve. 22

23

Section 20. Employees transferred.

24 (a) The employees of the Department of Financial and 25 Professional Regulation who are engaged in performing duties pertaining to any function transferred to the Department of 26 27 Health Professional Regulation under this Act shall be 28 transferred the Department of Health Professional to 29 Regulation.

In the case of a person employed by the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation to perform both duties pertaining to a function transferred to the Department of Health Professional Regulation under this Act and duties pertaining to a function retained by the Department of

Financial and Professional Regulation, the Director of Health Professional Regulation, in consultation with the Secretary of Financial and Professional Regulation, shall determine whether the employee shall be transferred to the Department of Health Professional Regulation. The employee shall not be transferred until this determination is made.

7 (b) The status and rights of employees transferred to the 8 Department of Health Professional Regulation, and the rights of 9 the State of Illinois and its agencies, under the Personnel 10 Code and applicable collective bargaining agreements or under 11 any pension, retirement, or annuity plan are not affected by 12 that transfer or by any other provision of this Act.

13 Section 25. Books and records transferred. All books, records, papers, documents, property (real and personal), 14 15 contracts, and pending business pertaining to any function 16 transferred to the Department of Health Professional Regulation under this Act, including but not limited to 17 18 material in electronic or magnetic format and necessary 19 computer hardware and software, shall be delivered to the Department of Health Professional Regulation. 20

In the case of books, records, papers, documents, property, 21 22 contracts, or pending business that pertains both to a function 23 Department Health Professional transferred to the of 24 Regulation under this Act and to a function retained by the 25 Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, the 26 Director of Health Professional Regulation, in consultation 27 with the Secretary of Financial and Professional Regulation, 28 shall determine whether the books, records, papers, documents, 29 property, contracts, or pending business shall be transferred 30 to the Department of Health Professional Regulation. The books, 31 records, papers, documents, property, contracts, or pending business shall not be transferred until this determination is 32 33 made.

Section 30. Unexpended moneys transferred. All unexpended

appropriations and balances and other moneys available for use in connection with any function transferred to the Department of Health Professional Regulation under this Act shall be transferred for use by that Department for the exercise of those functions. Unexpended balances so transferred shall be expended only for the purpose for which the appropriations were originally made.

8 In the case of an unexpended appropriation that pertains 9 both to a function transferred to the Department of Health Professional Regulation under this Act and to a function 10 11 retained by the Department of Financial and Professional 12 Regulation, the Director of Health Professional Regulation, in 13 consultation with the Secretary of Financial and Professional Regulation, 14 shall determine whether the unexpended 15 appropriation shall be transferred to the Department of Health 16 Professional Regulation. The unexpended appropriation shall 17 not be transferred until this determination is made.

18 Section 35. Exercise of transferred powers; savings provisions. The powers, duties, rights, and responsibilities 19 related to the functions transferred to the Department of 20 Health Professional Regulation under this Act are vested in and 21 22 shall be exercised by that Department. Each act done by the 23 Department of Health Professional Regulation or any of its 24 officers, employees, or agents in the exercise of those powers, 25 duties, rights, and responsibilities shall have the same legal 26 effect as if done by the Department of Financial and 27 Professional Regulation or the divisions, officers, employees, or agents of that agency. The transfer of functions to the 28 29 Department of Health Professional Regulation under this Act 30 does not affect any person's powers, duties, rights, or 31 responsibilities arising out of those transferred functions, except as otherwise provided in this Act. 32

33 Section 40. Officers, employees, and agents; penalties.
 34 Every officer, employee, and agent of the Department of Health

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Professional Regulation is, for any offense, subject to the same penalty or penalties, civil or criminal, as are prescribed by the law in effect on the effective date of this Act for the same offense by any officer, employee, or agent whose powers, duties, rights, and responsibilities are transferred under this Act.

7 Section 45. Reports, notices, or papers. Whenever reports 8 or notices are required to be made or given or papers or 9 documents furnished or served by any person to or upon the 10 Department of Financial and Professional Regulation in 11 connection with any function transferred from that Department to the Department of Health Professional Regulation under this 12 Act, the same shall be made, given, furnished, or served in the 13 same manner to or upon the Department of Health Professional 14 15 Regulation.

Section 50. Acts and actions unaffected by transfer. This 16 17 Act does not affect any act done, ratified, or canceled, or any 18 right occurring or established, before the effective date of this Act in connection with any function transferred from the 19 Department of Financial and Professional Regulation to the 20 21 Department of Health Professional Regulation under this Act. 22 This Act does not affect any action or proceeding had or commenced before the effective date of this Act in an 23 24 administrative, civil, or criminal cause regarding the 25 Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, but any 26 such action or proceeding may be prosecuted, defended, or 27 continued by the Department of Health Professional Regulation.

28 Section 55. Rules.

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(a) Any rule of the Department of Financial and
Professional Regulation that (i) relates to any function
transferred from the Department of Financial and Professional
Regulation to the Department of Health Professional Regulation
under this Act, (ii) was in full force on the effective date of

this Act, and (iii) was duly adopted by the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation shall become the rule of the Department of Health Professional Regulation. This Act does not affect the legality of any such rules contained in the Illinois Administrative Code.

(b) Any proposed rule filed with the Secretary of State by 6 the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation that 7 was pending in the rulemaking process on the effective date of 8 9 this Act and that pertains to any function transferred from the 10 Department of Financial and Professional Regulation to the 11 Department of Health Professional Regulation under this Act 12 shall be deemed to have been filed by the Department of Health 13 Professional Regulation.

(c) As soon as practicable after the effective date of this 14 Act, the Department of Health Professional Regulation shall 15 16 revise and clarify the rules transferred to it under this 17 Section to reflect the reorganization of functions effected by this Act, using the procedures for recodification of rules 18 19 available under the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act, 20 except that existing title, part, and section numbering for the 21 affected rules may be retained. The Department of Health Professional Regulation may propose and adopt other rules as 22 23 necessary for the purpose of revising and clarifying the rules transferred to the Department under this Section. 24
