Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Interest Act is amended by changing Section
- 5 4b as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 205/4b) (from Ch. 17, par. 6411)
- 7 Sec. 4b. In order to assure compliance with applicable
- 8 Federal law, any State agency having chartering or licensing
- 9 powers or regulatory or supervisory authority over a class of
- 10 creditors affected by this Act may promulgate rules and and
- 11 regulations to carry out the disclosure and other requirements
- 12 pertaining to the extension of credit under this Act and the
- 13 advertising of such extensions of credit.
