## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

4 Section 5. The Department of Transportation Law of the 5 Civil Administrative Code is amended by adding Section 2705-317 as follows: 6

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(20 ILCS 2705/2705-317 new)

8 Sec. 2705-317. Safe Routes to School Construction Program. (a) Upon enactment of a federal transportation bill with a 9 dedicated fund available to states for safe routes to schools, 10 the Department, in cooperation with the State Board of 11 Education and the Department of State Police, shall establish 12 and administer a Safe Routes to School Construction Program for 13 the construction of bicycle and pedestrian safety and 14 15 traffic-calming projects using the federal Safe Routes to

Schools P<u>rogram funds.</u> 16

17 (b) The Department shall make construction grants 18 available to local governmental agencies under the Safe Routes 19 to School Construction Program based on the results of a statewide competition that requires submission of Safe Routes 20 to School proposals for funding and that rates those proposals 21 on all of the following factors: 22

(1) Demonstrated needs of the grant applicant.

(2) Potential of the proposal for reducing child 24 25 injuries and fatalities.

26 (3) Potential of the proposal for encouraging increased walking and bicycling among students. 27

(4) Identification of safety hazards. (5) Identification of current and potential walking 29 30 and bicycling routes to school.

(6) Consultation and support for projects by 31 school-based associations, local traffic engineers, local 32

1	elected officials, law enforcement agencies, and school
2	officials.
3	(7) Proximity to parks and other recreational
4	facilities.
5	With respect to the use of federal Safe Routes to Schools
6	Program funds, prior to the award of a construction grant or
7	the use of those funds for a Safe Routes to School project
8	encompassing a highway, the Department shall consult with and
9	obtain approval from the Department of State Police and the
10	highway authority with jurisdiction to ensure that the Safe
11	Routes to School proposal is consistent with a statewide
12	pedestrian safety statistical analysis.
13	(c) On March 30, 2006 and each March 30th thereafter, the
14	Department shall submit a report to the General Assembly
15	listing and describing the projects funded under the Safe
16	Routes to School Construction Program.
17	(d) The Department shall study the effectiveness of the
18	Safe Routes to School Construction Program, with particular
19	emphasis on the Program's effectiveness in reducing traffic
20	accidents and its contribution to improving safety and reducing
21	the number of child injuries and fatalities in the vicinity of
22	a Safe Routes to School project. The Department shall submit a
23	report to the General Assembly on or before December 31, 2006
24	regarding the results of the study.
25	(e) The Department, the State Board of Education, and the
26	Department of State Police may adopt any rules necessary to
27	implement this Section.
28	Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon

29 becoming law.
