SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 2805/7 new

Amends the Department of Veterans Affairs Act. Creates the Veterans' Memorial Commission within the Department of Veterans Affairs. Authorizes the Commission to study, report, and advise on issues affecting veterans' memorials. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of Veterans Affairs Act is amended by adding Section 7 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 2805/7 new)
- 7 Sec. 7. Veterans' Memorial Commission. The Veterans' 8 Memorial Commission is created within the Department. The Commission shall gather information on memorial preservation 9 and management and advise State and local governments and other 10 entities in the creation, custody, care, and upkeep of 11 veterans' memorials. The Commission shall conduct studies and 12 make reports regarding the various laws and rules affecting 13 veteran's memorials to determine whether consolidation or 14 15 other changes in the laws or rules are needed to facilitate memorial preservation and to raise awareness of issues 16 affecting veterans' memorials. The Director shall appoint the 17 members of the Commission and shall determine the number of 18 19 members to be appointed. The members of the Commission shall include representatives of the Department, the American 20 21 Legion, the United States Armed Forces, the Veterans of Foreign 22 Wars, and any other members deemed appropriate by the Director. 23 Members shall serve without compensation, but may be reimbursed for necessary expenses related to official business from 24 25 appropriated funds available for that purpose.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
