"Section 5. The Department of Veterans Affairs Act is 4

amended by adding Section 7 as follows:

(20 ILCS 2805/7 new) 6

7 Sec. 7. Veterans' Memorial Commission. The Veterans' Memorial Commission is created within the Department. 8 Commission shall gather information on memorial preservation 9 and management and advise State and local governments and other 10 entities in the creation, custody, care, and upkeep of 11 veterans' memorials. The Commission shall conduct studies and 12 make reports regarding the various laws and rules affecting 13 veteran's memorials to determine whether consolidation or 14 other changes in the laws or rules are needed to facilitate 15 16 memorial preservation and to raise awareness of issues affecting veterans' memorials. The Commission shall be 17 composed of 12 members as follows: 2 members appointed by the 18 President of the Senate, 2 members appointed by the Minority 19 Leader of the Senate, 2 members appointed by the Speaker of the 20 21 House of Representatives, 2 members appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, one representative of 22 the Department of Veterans Affairs, one representative of the

American Legion, one representative of the United States Armed

- 1 Forces, and one representative of the Veterans of Foreign Wars.
- Members shall serve 2-year terms, without compensation, but may 2
- 3 be reimbursed for necessary expenses related to official
- business from appropriated funds available for that purpose. 4
- 5 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 6 becoming law.".
