If the Department of Transportation owns vacant 23 24 land within a county, the county may enter into a lease agreement with the Department for use of the vacant land. The 25 lease agreement may be for less than fair market value and must 26 27 prohibit the county from erecting any permanent structure upon 28 the property.
